

NEW AZ TPT TAX FORM INFORMATION

- Visit www.aztaxes.gov/home to download the Joint Tax Application (TPT) short form (JT1). The license will be provided within 24-48 hours. For more information visit www.azdor.gov/about/FAQs/TPT.aspx
- Click on “Registering a New Business”. A FAQ link is also available on the home page
- The form may be turned in (in person) at the Mesa office at 1840 S. Mesa Dr. Bldg. #1352 before 5 p.m. Monday-Friday
- The short form (JT1) is for “transient vendors” for special events such as fairs, shows, swap meets, etc.
- The annual license fee is \$12 for all the events you attend at one location
- When working out of the home use home address as business address
- If the business has no employees the owner will use their social security number
- A single-member LLC must have an EIN (Federal Employee ID) to obtain an Arizona TPT license. It can be obtained at www.irs.gov
- A seasonal vendor files their AZ tax form every 8 months or sooner (if preferred) at the end of the “season”
